We discussed updating our website and adding Instagram.

Kathy reported we have 591 media items added to the Collective Access catalogue.

This month's donation included 1969-1971 Echo newspapers and Directories for the Lake Forest Neighborhood.

Ted reported we have new volunteers. Two are doing research and writing related to Minikahda Vista neighborhood and Parktacular. Catherine Bishop has volunteered to help with Programing and setting a regular calendar of events.

We discussed past programing, most recently the Skunk Hollow tours and reviewed what we learned.

There was time for Open discussion. None being heard we adjourned.
